## History

- Founded in 1966 within Federation of Caving
- Own legal entity since 1989
- Integration to Act of Rescue 1999

## Financing

- Government (Yearly Rescue contribution)
- Rescue Fee
- Donation system
- Support of sightseeing mines (contribution per visitor)
- Sponsoring





## Government Cooperation

- Financial Aid
- Specific training
   e.g. operation management, press handling, peer education
- Various support
  - Initiate communication with other rescue services
  - Support on organisational topics as for example insurances or implementation of training quality checks
- Support during rescue operations
  - □ Organise e.g. helicopter, infrastructure, food,...
  - For big incidents: overall operation management no interference to cave rescueing





#### Insurance of the rescue team

For rescue operations, rescue drills and other operations

- Accident insurance (death, disability, salvage expenses, hospital daily allowance)
- Casualty insurance
- Legal protection insurance
- Comprehensive insurance for private automobiles

- Neighbouring countries
   Direct request to the cave rescue service
- Other countries

Request to the Austrian state
e.g. by International Red Cross and Red
Crescent Movement





## Rescue operations abroad

Preconditions for a log into the EU-rescue database of MIC (Monitoring and Information Centre)

- Personell
- Material and infrastructure
- Response time





## Caving in Austria

- For Expeditions a governmental permission is necessary.
   The Caving Federations are helping with the application.
- Permissions are also sent to the Rescue Services.
